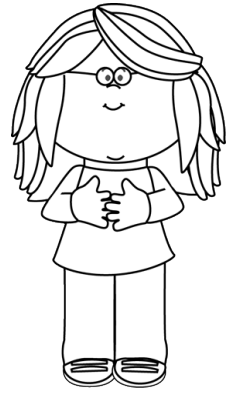


Managing Myself

The Rights I Have In OUR Classroom

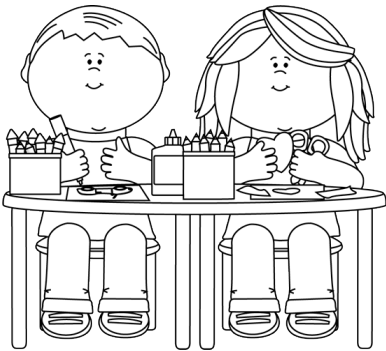


I have a right to be safe in our classroom.
